Glory to God! I write you this newsletter from the desk of Pastor Woolley here in the Village of Hope giving you an update of the glorious victorious mission works that have happened since our last newsletter and our return trip from the U.S. in December 2010. It is now May 2011 and we are packing our bags to return to our beloved friends and the good old USA for a time of rest from our labors here in Belize. My two daughters will be travelling with me to help me load **two buses** with needed supplies for the church and Shekinah Store. We would like to load **a 40th container** to send on the ship while we drive the two buses through Mexico. We are praying that God moves on the hearts and blesses people who receive our newsletter with the money to be able to support this work. We must have your help to get it done.

We are doing what Jesus said to do in Matthew Chapter 25 verse 24. King Jesus **says feed the hungry and clothe the naked**. Read this chapter and you will see why we do what we do. I can promise you and God as my witness since you have last seen me in December 2010 with the help of my two daughters, staff of King Jesus Ministries, and many others who are members we have baptized, preached every week at the church, opened Shekinah Store weekly, and held communion. Other events which occurred are the giving away of Christmas and Easter toys and gifts. We also took a mission trip in a large bus with 20 of our church members from our church to a village called Arenal and gave out Bibles, candy canes, toys, and bikes blessing the poorest of the poor. We did another mission trip to the bottom end of Mexico bordering Belize to give out tracks and minister to the people there.

This year we were able to put in three teams in a canoe race called the La Ruta Maya Belize River Challenge. La Ruta Maya translates to 'The Mayan Route'. The Mayan Indians of Belize took this 4 day, 180 mile journey down the Belize River to the sea. The side of our canoes read King Jesus Ministries and **WWJD** (What Would Jesus Do). Over a 100 canoes were in this race, but we were the only canoes painted white with bright red letters sharing the testimony of Jesus. We gave out bracelets which said **WWJD**. Many people were happy to see us show up with our bus which has the phrases **Jesus Saves, Praise, the Lord, and Turn or Burn** professionally written on the front and sides of it. So you may wonder, what are you getting in return for the money and support you give. You are helping to provide a shining light in a dark place in the Village of Hope. You will be able to see Live at Channel 5, which is one of our major news channels here in Belize covering the entire country, interviewing me about the mission work we did during the La Ruta Maya. They said that they liked what we were doing. I have sent you a copy of the DVD of the La Ruta Maya to watch. My youngest daughter Daniella, paddled in one of the canoes along with other members of our church. The other DVD is a video we have done in the past years which shows my oldest daughter Deangela singing on stage. You will see the village of Arenal and how we give out church money for people to go shopping at the Shekinah Store. People can go get what they want with dignity and not feel shamed begging for help.

However I do beg you on behalf of the poor, hungry, naked, and needy for your support once again. Please go to our website www.kingjesusministries.com to see the videos of the canoe race and mission work video. My daughters and I will be in the Knoxville Area on Lovell Rd as we normally are. Please call us at 865-924-7727 and we will come pick up your donation or make time to be with you for dinner, lunch, or speak at your church or group. We have pictures, a testimony to share, and my daughters sing beautifully. We arrive on May 15 2011 and depart June 6 2011 and will be collecting mainly children's clothes, pots, pans, dishes, school supplies, canned food, new or used shoes and of course money to be able to transport everything back on the ship and our travel through Mexico. Jesus said **Give and it shall be given**.
